

# Cleaning and Caring Guide for El Yoku's Bathroom Accessories



## Robe Hooks

### Cleaning Method

- To keep your robe hooks looking great, gently wipe the surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- For daily cleaning, mix a bit of neutral liquid soap with water, then apply it to the surface.
- Rinse thoroughly with water and dry off any leftover moisture with a soft flannel cloth.

### Care Tips

- Steer clear of abrasive materials like scouring pads and avoid harsh chemical cleaners, as they can damage the finish.

## Towel Bars

### Cleaning Method

- Give your towel bars a quick wipe with a damp cloth and some mild soap on a regular basis.

## Shower Seat

### General Maintenance
